Ensure that your community's most vulnerable people don't miss out.

The U.S. government is issuing stimulus checks to every eligible American. But there's an extra step required for millions of people of low socioeconomic status (SES) – those most in need of the stimulus checks.

The IRS has created an online form for people who don't normally file a tax return, known as non-filers. It's a free and easy way to provide basic information so people of low SES can receive their economic impact payment as soon as possible.

On their own or with the aid of a trusted person, the individual can visit [IRS.gov](https://www.irs.gov) and select the non-filer application.

This free resource is designed for:

- People whose gross income from their 2018 or 2019 federal income tax return was under \$12,200 for single filers or \$24,400 for married couples
- People who aren't required to file a 2018 or 2019 federal income tax return for other reasons
- People who receive Social Security, Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) or Railroad Retirement benefits and have children younger than 17

The process only takes a few minutes to complete.

1. Click [Non-Filers: Enter Payment Info Here](#) on [irs.gov](https://www.irs.gov).
2. Provide name, address, Social Security number and that of dependent information.
3. If available, enter bank account information. This will allow the IRS to deposit directly into the account; otherwise, payment will be mailed to the address provided.

Spread the word and share the impact.

- Religious associations and congregations
